Dear James,

May I confirm the results of earlier discussions concerning your visit to the UK and residency at Imperial College: as Director of Visual Arts Programmes at Imperial College I have agreed:

1. Arts Catalyst (Nicola Triscott) are the main sponsors of your three month visit covering the period September to December 1998.
2. In association with Arts Catalyst, Imperial College will appoint you as Artist in Residence for the stated period.
3. As Artist in Residence you will be offered an office at Imperial College and access to such facilities as are necessary for your residency.
4. As Artist in Residence you will spend a major portion of your time (not less than 70%) at the College.

We understand that most of this time will be occupied with your work in preparation for the Arts Catalyst / Imperial College exhibition in November 1998. In addition the College may request occasional lectures to staff / students at times and dates to be agreed.

5. We have further agreed with Arts Catalyst to contribute a sum of money to provide partial support for your living expenses and materials. Arts Catalyst will fund the remainder, and will handle all financial arrangements with you.

6. Finally, as is usual for such visits, we ask you to agree to seek no other remuneration while resident in the U.K.

We are all looking forward to having you with us at Imperial. We shall remain in close contact with Arts Catalyst should there be any further questions. Have a good trip.
