Dear Linley and Jim

Enclosed please find two formal letters of agreement, which Jim should carry with him when he comes to London and should be ready to show immigration. They confirm that he is here by invitation and that his accommodation, etc, are covered while he is here.

I understand that Jim is arriving at London Gatwick at 6.45 am on Wednesday 2 September. Rob will meet him at the airport and take him to his accommodation, which is at 8 Arrow House, Phillip Street, London N1. In terms of an itinerary, we will have lunch with Jim on his arrival day, but otherwise leave him to recover. We have a meeting arranged at Imperial College with Judith Richards on Thursday morning, and other meetings, including one media interview, on the Friday. But generally, we will take it easy to let Jim get over his jet lag! (And hope he doesn't get another cold this time).

The following week is the week of Jim's presentation at the British Association for the Advancement of Science's Festival in Wales. The presentation is on Thursday 10 September. Jim will travel down the day before and be met by Rob, who will be at the festival all that week. I will join them on the day. The British Association has requested a press conference due to the level of media attention and this has been scheduled for 12.45 pm. It will be an opportunity for journalists to meet Jim and ask questions about his work. The presentation itself is at 5.30 pm. I think it will be an exciting start to Jim's residency in this country.
