Negotiating your Assessment Criteria Software Application/Design Document

Your assessment criteria **must be** negotiated and agreed upon by your team as a whole and the unit organisers. This agreement **must be** signed by both parties before **5th November 1998**. If a team fails to agree upon a set of criteria by this date, the prescribed set of assessment criteria will be implemented by default.

It is your responsibility to ensure that your team negotiates with the unit organisers and that your set of criteria are agreed upon and signed by the date given.

<u>Assignment (1)</u> <u>Software Application</u>
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Your task is to plan, design and develop an interactive multimedia application (CD-ROM) around issues of radioactivity in conjunction with *The Arts Catalyst: the science-art agency*. The primary audience for the CD-ROM is secondary school children (ages 11-16). Rather than deliver a prescriptive brief to you, *The Arts Catalyst* has suggested that you produce proposals for their consideration.

For the purposes of this assignment you will work in teams each consisting of five students. It is expected that the teams will work on a specific aspect of radioactivity, each producing a small stand-alone application.

This assignment carries 50% of the total marks for the unit
