This is to confirm our arrangements for your residency at Imperial College from 2 September to 29 November 1998.

You will arrive at London Gatwick at 6.45 am on Wednesday 2 September. Rob La Frenais will meet you at the airport and take you to your accommodation, which is at 8 Arrow House, Phillip Street, London N1. If you encounter any problems at the airport, please call me at home on 0181 672 1090. I will wait to hear from Rob that you have successfully met up before I leave for work.

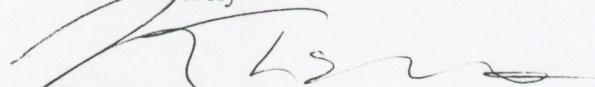
We have agreed with Imperial College a combined fee of £3500 for your residency and commission for the touring exhibition Atomic, inclusive of your day to day living expenses. The Arts Catalyst is providing accommodation for you for the duration of the residency (address as above). The Arts Catalyst will cover all reasonable overheads (electricity, gas, etc). The Arts Catalyst will pay for agreed travel costs.

Imperial College will appoint you as Artist in Residence for the period 2 September - 29 November 1998. As Artist in Residence, Imperial College will provide you with an office and access to such facilities as are necessary for your residency. A materials budget will be provided by Imperial College and The Arts Catalyst.

Most of your time will be occupied with your work in preparation for the Arts Catalyst/Imperial College exhibition in November 1998 and its subsequent tour. In addition the College may request occasional lectures to staff/ students at times and dates to be agreed. The Arts Catalyst will request occasional lectures and presentations outside the College at times and dates to be agreed, as well as your participation in an educational project with one or more schools at a later stage in your residency.

As is usual for such visits, you will agree to seek no other remunerative work while resident in the UK.
