Dear Janet and Ed and Lenny and Christopher —

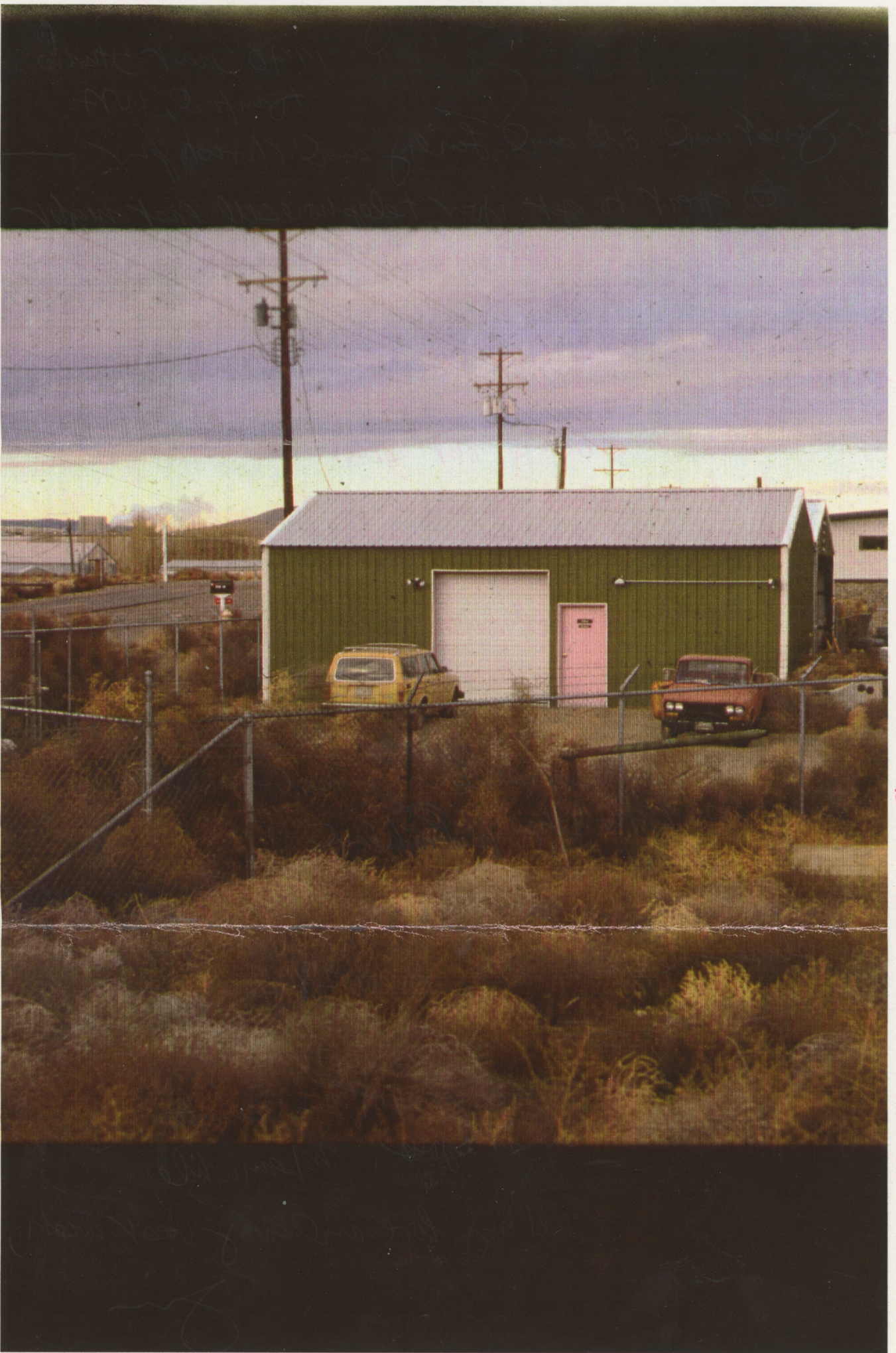
